James Steenberg is an environmental scientist focusing on the ecology and sustainable management of forests in a changing climate. He is the forest carbon and climate change analyst with the Nova Scotia Department of Lands and Forestry. He is also an adjunct professor at Dalhousie University, where he teaches and supervises students on several topics relating to forests and forestry. He received his PhD in environmental applied science and management from Ryerson University, much of which was completed at the USDA Forest Service's Northern Research Station while on a Fulbright Exchange. Before beginning with the Department in 2018, James worked as a Killam Postdoctoral Fellow at Dalhousie and as the principal consultant with Ecotone Consulting.
